IMPORTANT: PLEASE, if you want to keep these trails open, ONLY RIDE ON MARKED BIKE TRAILS.

- ** **WARNING** You could be ticketed and fined for repeatedly riding off of the marked bike trails.
- Double Track bike trails marked with WHITE bike signs and arrows.
- Single Track bike trails marked with GREEN bike signs and arrows.
- The bike trails are generally marked for one-way travel, but there are a few short areas of two-way traffic.

Double Track Loops:

Y Loop - YELLOW circles, 2.5 miles

B Loop - BLACK circles, 4.5 miles

T Loop - TEAL circles, 6.0 miles

Single Track Loop and Shortcuts:

Single Track Loop - 10.5 miles

International Mountain Bike Association Trail Rules:

- 1. Ride on open trails only.
- 2. Leave no trace.
- 3. Control your bicycle.
- 4. Always yield trail
- 5. Never scare animals.
- 6. Plan ahead.
